

Bowling Volunteer Descriptions (General “day of” Volunteers)

Lane Monitor – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Assists teams on the lanes. Bowling experience helpful but not required. Reports to Pit Monitor who will address any bowling equipment/sport related questions.

Pit Monitor – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Bowling experience required. Assists Bowling Commissioner, Competition Manager and Polar Bowl Staff with managing the event. Oversees 10 or more lanes.

Awards Announcer – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Works under Awards Leader. Uses script to announce awards presentations, and honored guest/presenters.

Awards – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Works under Awards Leader. Prepares awards for presentation. Assists with presentations.

Food Services – *Special Olympics Alaska* – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Works under Food Service Leader. Assists with management of line and process during Lunch and Dinners.

Food Services – *Hotels (Clarion Suites)* - *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Works under Food Services Leader. Assists with management of line and process during Friday/Sunday Dinner, Saturday/Sunday Breakfast.

Volunteer Check In/Information Services – *(military personnel and nonmilitary volunteers)* Works under Volunteer Leader. Registers “day of” volunteers, gives them their t-shirt, and directs the volunteer to the appropriate leader and assigned position. Communicates with Competition and other leaders to ensure open positions are filled in.

Operations - *(military personnel)* works under Special Olympics Alaska staff and Operations Leader. Assists with loading/unloading trucks, setting up/taking down venues, maintaining venue during competition.

Bus/Transportation Escort – *(Military personnel)* authorized by Military POC to hold position. Rides buses between Hotels & Polar Bowl, and Special Olympics Alaska Shuttle Pick up & Polar Bowl. Ensures proper ID is shown prior to boarding bus. Authorizes bus passengers to access base via the bus.
