

Local WAPS testing procedures

All WAPS testing sessions begin at 0730. Unless an alternate time is annotated on your AF1566. The door to the testing room will be closed precisely at 0730. Members are not allowed to enter the testing room once the door has been closed. Any member arriving after the testing room door has been closed will be reported to their unit as a no-show. Our clocks are set to the Naval Observatory time and checked weekly to ensure proper time is displayed.

Members must display a valid military ID card prior to entrance into the testing room. Line badges are not valid forms of ID.

Food, drinks, and gum are not allowed in the testing room.

Cell phones are prohibited items and are not allowed in the testing room.

Watches of any kind are considered a prohibited item and are not allowed in the testing room. A clock with a countdown timer is in the testing room for members to keep track of time remaining.

Our waiting area has lockers available for members to store personal/prohibited items while testing. These lockers do not have locks, members may bring their own lock if they desire to secure the contents, and our office is not responsible for the contents of the lockers.

While in the waiting area between test sessions noise must be kept to a minimum so not to disturb others testers.
