



Mobile Medical Simulation Trailer

Description

The Mobile Medical Simulation Trailer will allow units to use an enclosed, state-of-the-art medical lab at their training location, regardless of weather condition. Through the use of medical mannequins and computer technology, combat medics, emergency medical technicians, combat lifesavers, and others are challenged to provide routine-to-advanced first aid to a life-like casualty. Audiovisual equipment and feedback from the mannequins provide the training audience with essential after action review capabilities. Prior to the Mobile Medical Simulation Trailer, units relied on casualty actors with casualty cards when training in the field, which lacked realism. The Mobile Medical Simulation Trailer will be available for use in the Joint Pacific Alaska Range Complex (JPARG) in September 2012.
