



### Indicators of High Avalanche Hazard

- Evidence of previous slides on “similar” slopes
- Recent heavy snowfall adds stress to snowpack
- High wind – snow plumes off peaks
- Visible fracture lines in snow – ”shooting cracks”
- Audible settling of the snowpack – ”whumping”
- Rapid temperature rise
- Rain on snow
- Slushy spring snow – sinking in over boot tops

## Abandoned Vehicles

### Why are abandoned vehicles a problem?

Abandoned vehicles are expensive to remove, have a negative impact on the environment & they look unsightly and lower the quality of life in our community. They are often times a target for vandals or criminals. They contain and leak hazardous wastes.

JBER abandoned vehicle numbers:

- 2012 = 260+ Towed (Increased SFS emphasis & towing/disposal contract)
- 2011 = 53 Towed
- 2010 = 80 Towed

## Abandoned Vehicles (Cont)

### What does an Abandoned Vehicle Look Like?

- Parked at the same location for an extended period
- Vehicle displays obvious signs of non-use (flat tires, broken windows, excessive snow build up/berms, expired license plates, missing major components, etc.)
- Call the Security Forces Desk at 552-3421 or 384-0823 to report a suspected abandoned vehicle

### When is my POV at Risk of being Towed?

- Vehicle is illegally parked, interferes with the orderly flow of traffic
- Vehicle interferes with CEG snow removal
- Vehicle located in an area where it interferes with mission activities
- Vehicle presents a risk (real or perceived) during an elevated threat

## Abandoned Vehicles (Cont)

### The Abandoned Vehicle Process

- SFS tags vehicle with a DD Form 2504/Abandoned Vehicle Notice
- Search U.S.-wide DMV database, query AK DPS APSIN, Microsoft Outlook, AKO, TLO, Alpha Roster's, SFMIS and COPS
- Send email to owner and First Sergeants (read receipt attached)
- Contact owner telephonically
- Tow vehicle via DD Form 2505/Abandoned Vehicle Removal Authorization, and DD Form 2506/Vehicle Impoundment Report
- Vehicle storage fees \$15/day plus towing fee and services

## **Abandoned Vehicles & Parking**

### **When Deployed, on extended TDY or Leave**

- Prominently display contact information (name & number) inside the vehicle for a responsible person SFS or others can use should your vehicle need to be moved or otherwise attended to. Unit & Organizational leadership should also have this information.
- Use designated deployment/TDY parking areas when made available.

### **A reminder about RVs**

- Trailers, boats, ATVs, campers, snow machines, etc...may only be parked in housing, dorm/barracks areas or elsewhere on base from 1200 on Friday until 1200 on Monday.
- Otherwise use secure JBER FSS or Off-Base RV storage lots.





**ODR Winter OPS: 384-1475/76 and 552-3998/4599**

- **Rent Snow Machines, Ice Fishing Gear & more**
- **Mandatory safety training to rent snow machines**
- **Snow Machine Safety Classes:**
  - Students receive local safety course certification
  - Cost is \$40 if snow machine is needed, free if you have own snow machine (\$40 refunded with first ODR snow machine trip or full price rental)
  - Training must be conducted in advance of rental
  - Soldiers completing WAQ snow machine trips receive free certification
- **Unit training/trips, we can do that too:** Can be scheduled with two weeks notice, you tell us when/where you want to go, minimum of 6 people
- **Guided Snow Machine trips:** 16 & 23 February, \$150, call for details
- **Winter Classes:** Snow Machine Safety, Avalanche Awareness, Hypothermia, Frostbite, Snow Shoeing, Wilderness Safety
- **Special events:** Customer Appreciation Specials 17 – 23 February







UPPER LEVEL PLAN





## **Managed Care Support Contractor Transition**

- TriWest Healthcare Alliance will cease to administer TRICARE in the West Region after 31 Mar 13
- UnitedHealthcare Military & Veteran Services (United) has been awarded the contract to administer TRICARE in the West Region, effective 1 Apr 13
  - United will assume staffing in TRICARE Service Centers, processing enrollment applications, and providing TRICARE educational briefings on 19 Feb 13
- There are no changes in the TRICARE benefit associated with this contract change

- United Healthcare introduction letters were sent to each beneficiary
  - If you have not received one within the next month, contact United at 1-877-988-9378
  - Contact DEERS to update your current address: 1-800-538-9552
- Authorizations approved by TriWest will continue to be valid until the end date on the authorization, or May 30, 2013 whichever comes earlier, with the exception of obstetric/maternity authorizations
  - Continuation of specialty care required after the expiration date should be coordinated through United
- Maternity authorization requests received by TriWest prior to 3-31-13 will be valid for 312 days to allow for uninterrupted prenatal and maternity care

- All Hazardous Material users require EESOH-MIS accounts
- All Hazardous Material requires authorization
  - Authorizations are based on process and usage
- All materials are tracked via bar code (Cradle to grave)
- Hazardous waste (unused/unserviceable HM) must be turned into the hazardous waste center (TSD)




